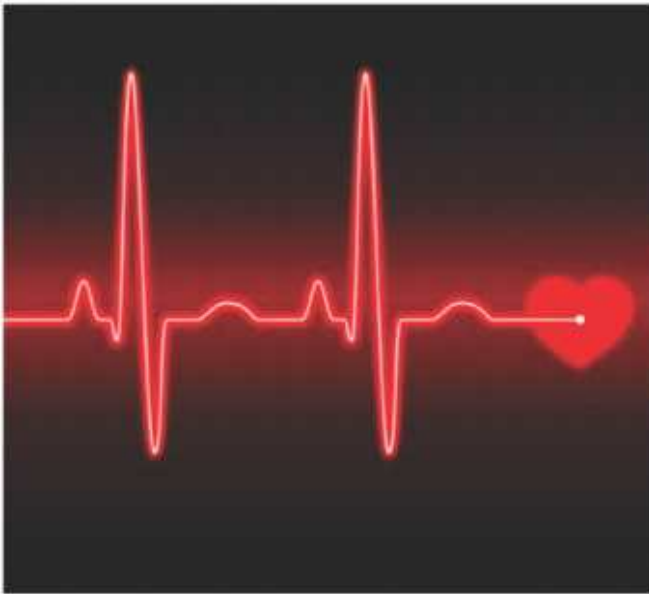

This includes healthcare professional who require this specialized knowledge for their job.

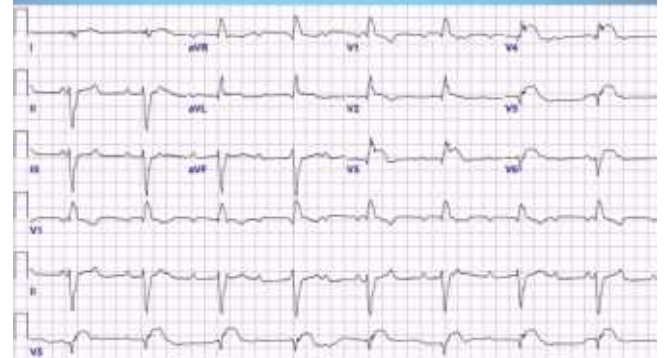
Goals and Objectives
